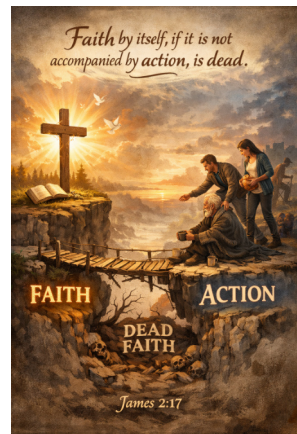

Pop In Cafe

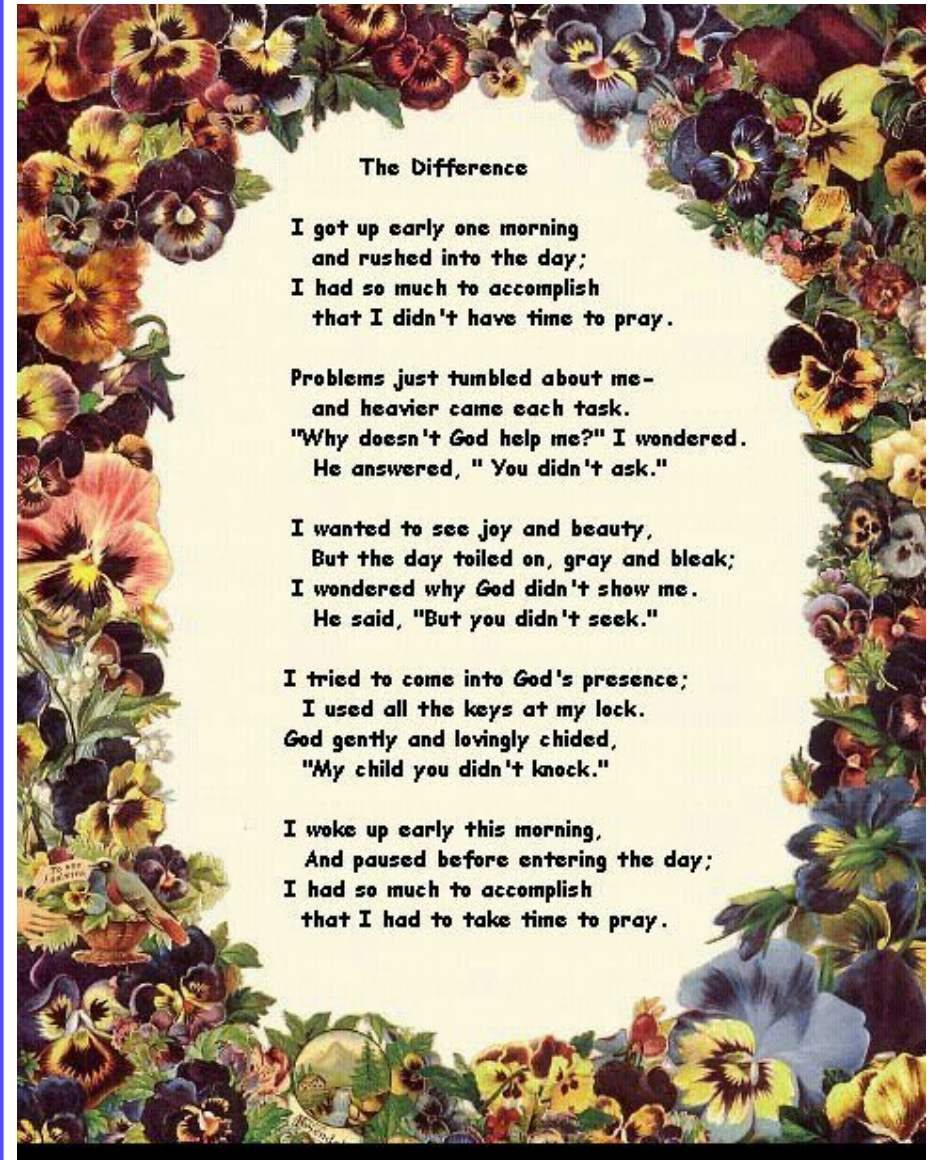
Friendly company is so much better than sitting at home alone.
