They meet in various homes and at the church. A time for old and new friends to enjoy one another's company and voice any questions or queries they may have.

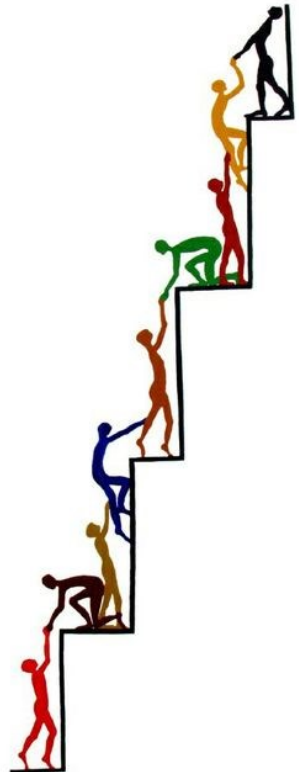


YOUTH GROUP.
