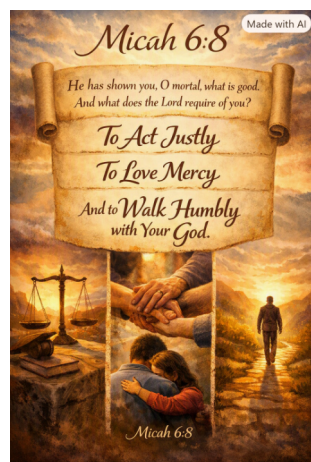

Gardening/outside day - TASK 2

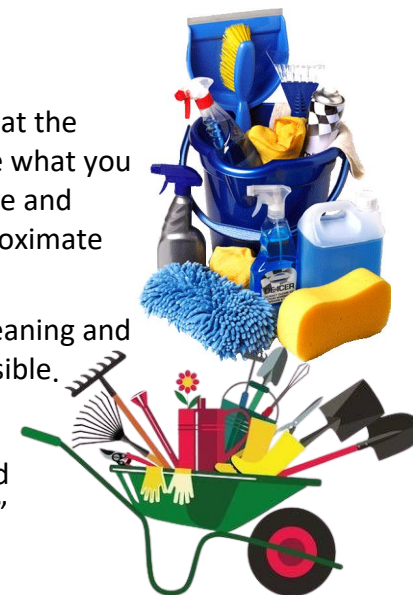

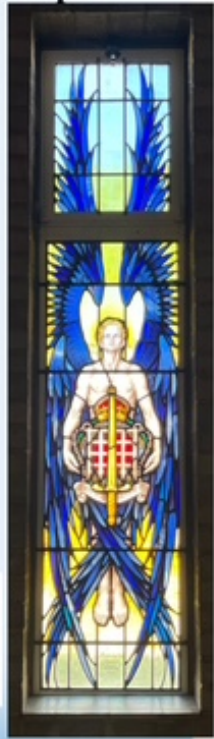
