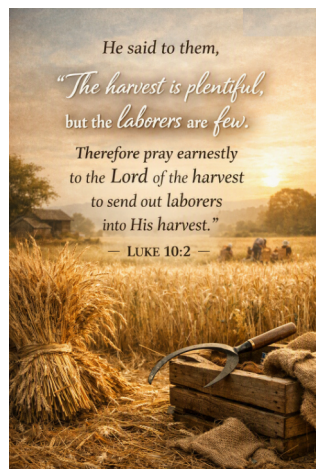

Come and be blessed, and take the opportunity to have a natter while you work—no stress!

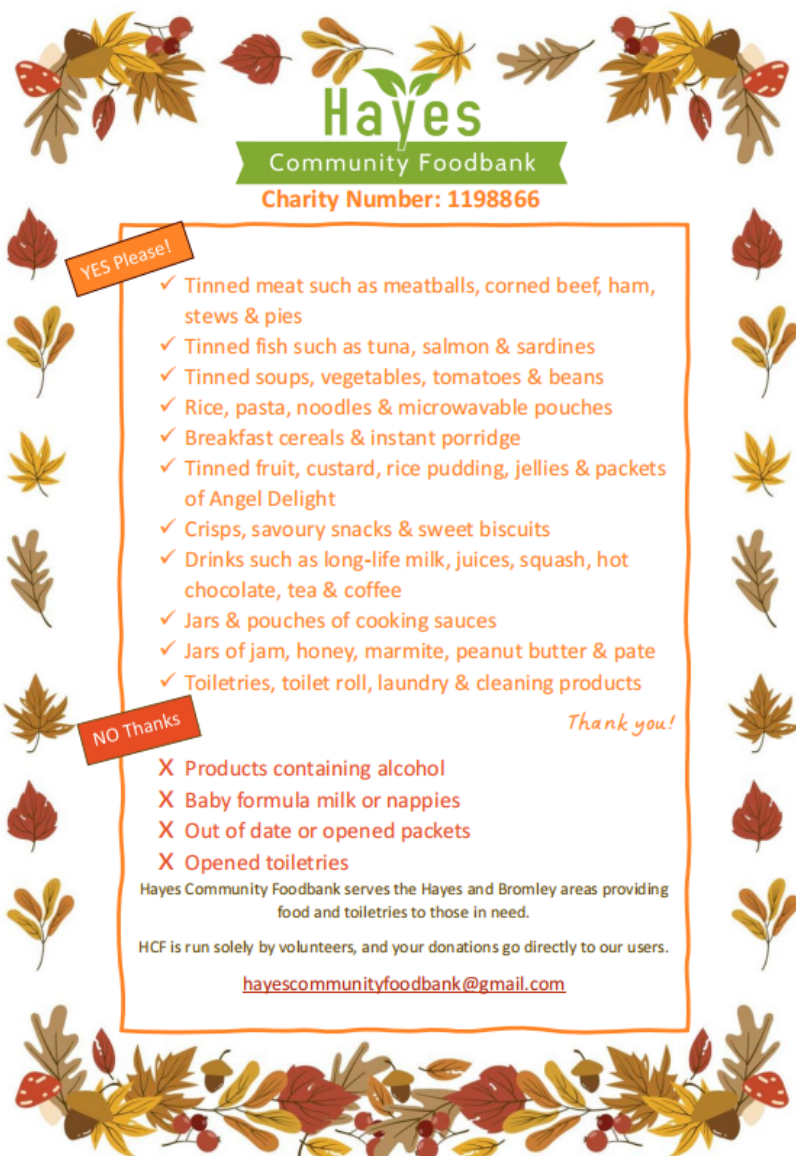
